

## Rules and Expectations:

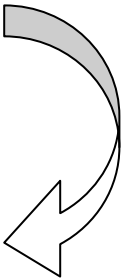

Exhibitors are interested in the student's educational experience as they are the future workforce. Professional conduct and manners are appreciated.**

Educators and chaperones, please review these simple rules with your students:

- Students are to stay with your assigned group at all times
- no more than ten students in a group –CMTS is a large show and the aisles may be crowded. You don't want to get separated.
- Make sure your badge is visible - it is a requirement to enter the exhibit hall.
- Student Friendly exhibitors- look for exhibitors with the Student Summit sign posted in the booth. Be sure to identify your group to the person in the booth.
- Do not crowd booths that are busy with customers, or if they are already hosting another student group. Either wait, or come back later.
- Listen and watch attentively.
- Raise your hand to ask a question and be sure to state your name and the school you are with.
- Wear appropriate attire- the students may be meeting their future employer!
- NO sandals allowed- must wear closed toed shoes.
- Please do not pick up anything without permission - wait until the person in the booth offers the samples, candy, food items, or literature.
- Plan on staying no longer than 20 minutes at any exhibit.
- Be sure to thank the present(s) at each booth that you visit.
- Be aware there is working equipment in many of the exhibit booths and it is very dangerous to reach for something in these areas without asking for permission.
- Be prompt in meeting your bus at the bus drop-off/pick-up location.
